ENTRY FEE

One pen free for new competitors \$ 10 fee per entry (with exception to Black & Coloured) \$15 for late entries received after Monday 6th November.

STANDARD BY LAWS AND REGULATIONS

- 67. All sheep must be entered in the name of bonafide owner and have been in his/her possession at least two months prior to date of the show.
- 68. The giving of a prize to a sheep shall imply that the judges are satisfied that such sheep is fairly shorn.
- 69. Definition of a hogget. A sheep born after July 1 in any one year shall be considered a hogget up to and including December 31 the following year.
- 70. Hogget's now to be eligible to compete for champion prizes.
- 71. All sheep in pedigree shorn classes must be shorn on or after July 20th.
- 72. Championships will only be awarded as provided whether there are at least three exhibitors, unless, in the opinion of the judge an animal is deemed worthy of the award.
- 73. Reserve champions to be selected from the first and second prize sheep in respective divisions and a certificate issue to the reserve champion.
- 74. No stud sheep to be entered, but ram lambs will be eligible in Prime Stock Classes.
- 78. Natural condition sheep rules: a declaration must be made on the entry form station (1) the actual date the sheep were shorn, (2) that they were shorn evenly and close to the skin, (3) that the wool has not been trimmed or locked in any way since (4) that the sheep have not been housed or covered at any time. Any indication of artificial colouring or oiling will disqualify.

SPECIAL LOCAL RULES

- 1. No sheep permitted to be removed from pens before 3 pm without the permission of the Chief Steward.
- 2. No sheep may be entered in more than one class, with the exception of special class entries.
- 3. All judging will commence at 9.00 am Saturday (Pets begin at 9.30am) and entries must be in their respective positions by that time.
- 4. No stud sheep eligible in flock classes.
- 5. In classes for ewe with lamb or lambs, lambs will be considered in the judging.
- 6. All classes to be natural condition sheep.
- 7. All male entries must be accompanied by a Brucellosis certificate.
- 8. In all shorn sheep classes shearing dates after 20 July and before 1 September.
- 9. The awarding of prizes is made at Judges Discretion.
- 10. Sheep in the breed classes must be from Stud / Recorded sheep flocks.

Farm employees can enter these export classes. Prizes will be paid to the employee, but payments from the meat processing plant will go to the employer.

Rules:

- 1. Points will be allocated to non-export grade lambs (T/ F/ C/ PH's) but will result in disqualification of the pen.
- 2. Breed or cross information is to be supplied with all entries.
- 3. Detained animals will be included (this will save arguments over the reasons for detaining).
- 4. Judge's decision is final.
- 5. Maximum 3 entries per exhibitor per class.

More emphasis will be given to overall eye appraisal and conformation in conjunction with the standard Meat Board grading and point's allocation. Eye appraisal points will be given to each lamb.

NOTE: Kill date for lambs is the Monday following the show day and all lambs must remain at the show grounds.

NOTE: Please make sure GST Numbers and SFF Member IDs are on entry forms and ASDs are supplied with lambs at the loading banks. If you are not a SFF member, please email Max Speakman max.speakman@silverfernfarms.co.nz or Richard Baines richard.baines@silverfernfarms.co.nz to register.


