ORDER OF THE DAY

7.00am Penning of sheep begins

8.30am All sheep must be penned and smoko entries delivered. What's For Smoko judging commences.

9.00am Sheep, pet day and stock judging commences

9.15am Morning tea 12.30pm Prizegiving 1.00pm Lunch

STANDARD BY LAWS & REGULATIONS

- All sheep must be entered in the name of bona fide owner and have been in his/her possession at least two months prior to date of the show.
- 2. Definition of a hogget. A sheep born after July 1 in any one year shall be considered a hogget up to and including December 31 the following year.
- 3. Hoggets are eligible to compete for champion prizes.
- 4. All sheep in pedigree shorn classes must be shorn on or after July 20th.
- Championships will only be awarded as provided whether there are at least three exhibitors, unless, in the opinion of the judge an animal is deemed worthy of the award.
- 6. Reserve champions to be selected from the first and second prize sheep in respective divisions.

SPECIAL LOCAL RULES

- 1. If 3 entries, only 1st and 2nd prize money will be awarded. If 2 entries, only 1st prize money will be awarded.
- 2. No sheep permitted to be removed from pens before 3pm without the permission of the Chief Steward.
- No sheep may be entered in more than one class, except for special class entries. 3.
- 4. All judging will commence at 9.00am Saturday and entries must be in their respective positions by 8.30am.
- 5. No stud sheep eligible in commercial classes except class 3101.
- In classes for ewe with lamb/s, lambs will be considered in the judging. 6.
- 7. All classes to be natural condition sheep. Any indication of artificial colouring or oiling will disqualify.
- All male entries must be accompanied by a Brucellosis certificate.
- The awarding of prizes is made at judge's discretion.
- 10. Sheep in stud all breed classes must be registered on Sheep Improvement Ltd (SIL) or NZ Sheep Breeders Association.

SUPREME AWARDS

SUPREME CHAMPION SHEEP OF SHOW

This competition will be judged between the Supreme Champion Black & Coloured Sheep, Champion All Breeds Ewe, and Champion All Breeds Ram. The Supreme Champion Ribbon will be presented to the winner.

RESERVE CHAMPION SHEEP OF SHOW

This competition will be judged between the Supreme Champion Black & Coloured Sheep, Champion All Breeds Ewe and Champion All Breeds Ram. The Reserve Champion Ribbon will be presented to the winner.

BEST WOOLLED SHEEP OF SHOW

All wool breed sheep excluding black and coloured classes.

Rules:

- 1. More emphasis will be given to overall eye appraisal and conformation in conjunction with the standard Meat Board grading and point's allocation. Eye appraisal points will be given to each lamb.
- 2. Points will be allocated to non-export grade lambs (T/ F/ C/ PH's) but will result in disqualification of the pen.
- 3. Detained animals will be included (to save arguments over the reasons for detaining).
- 4. Maximum 3 entries per exhibitor per class.
- 5. Farm employees can enter the export classes. Prizes will be paid to the employee, payments from the meat processing plant will go to the employer.
- All entries in export lamb classes will be sent to Silver Fern Farms, Takapau unless stewards are notified.
